## Public Summary

The main objective of this deliverable is to consolidate the market and technical aspects related to the exploitation and future commercialization of the results generated within the AENEAS project. This includes the definition of an appropriate intellectual property rights (IPR) management approach, an assessment of the international context of advanced energy storage systems for maritime applications, and the identification of suitable pathways to protect and exploit the project outcomes. The deliverable aims to support the transition of AENEAS results from validated technical solutions towards exploitable products, services and business models, while ensuring consistency with the consortium's exploitation strategy.

In addition, this deliverable includes an analysis of the project outcomes from an exploitation perspective, identifying their potential across different exploitation routes and assessing their readiness for market uptake.
